The Reverend Mike Endicott is the founder and current leader of the Order of Jacob's Well, Wales, UK. The Order of Jacob's Well was founded by a group of lay and ordained Christians involved in the Christian healing ministry in south Wales. These days it can be found throughout England, Scotland and Wales, and is expanding worldwide. The Order of Jacob's Well is fully ecumenical in terms of both its membership and its outreach.

At the heart of the Christian Gospel is a message about wholeness and healing in Christ. At the start of the 1990's Mike Endicott was aware of this and equally aware of the lack of connection being made between the Gospel message of healing and the very many people who were searching for healing in their own lives. Together with a few others Mike began to open his house to people for prayer. They saw results and were greatly encouraged.

He and others then found a home in Pontnewydd, where the vicar was willing to exercise authority over the healing ministry. The ministry of prayer and healing was approved by Archbishop Rowan Williams. A vacant Chapel came on the market and after prayer was bought to become the Well Centre, a place for healing prayer. There was no advertising of the prayer ministry available there; word spread through interested and committed individuals.

Mike has always been surprised at the number of people who have come for prayer and counseling. He has made links with other groups throughout the country who have a concern for healing through prayer. Gradually he has extended his ministry with greater knowledge and experience. This has fed into a growing teaching ministry, both in the UK and abroad.

Mike's particular ministry was authorized by Rowan Williams, then Archbishop of Wales, in two ways: In the first place, he was ordained to the permanent diaconate in 1997. This was on the basis of recognition of his existing ministry, rather than following a conventional pattern of selection and training. Secondly, the work has been authorized with the inauguration of the Order of Jacob's Well based at the Well Centre, endorsed by the Archbishop of Canterbury.
